All exhibits not in place at that time will not be judged and no refund of entry fee will be given. Judging will begin at **9:00 a.m., Wednesday, June 12, 2024**.
- Items in Class -A- cannot be shown in single classes. Judged on quality, 60%; Assortment, 20%; Attractiveness, 20%. **DISPLAYS MUST BE MADE BY EXHIBITOR WITH NO ASSISTANCE BY ADULTS.** Vegetables, Grains & Seeds and Herbs other than those listed in Lot Listings may be shown in this class. **Limited to one entry per exhibitor per Lot number.**
- **Entries must be grown by exhibitor.**
- Entries will be released **Monday, June 17, 2024** between **9:00 a.m.** and **7:00 p.m.**
- **Exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries under any one lot number**
- Wash all vegetables and display on a white paper plate. Three inch tops on carrots, beets, and onions. Do not peel onions.

LOT #

1 - Display – Vegetables or Grains and Seeds

2ft. by 2ft. maximum space with a minimum of 8 varieties. Display must be made by the Exhibitor. Required number of each variety is the same as in open class. Innovation in display will be given points.

2 – Display – Herbs

2 ft. by 2 ft. maximum space with a minimum of 5 different varieties. Display must be made by the exhibitor. Required number of each variety is the same as in the open class. Innovation in display will be given points.

3- Vegetable Art

Creation must include a minimum of 5 different vegetables (no flowers, no fruit) and not to exceed 24" x 24".

4- Mr. Potato Head

Using a potato, design a Mr. or Mrs. Potato Head using fruits and vegetables. No minimum amount of fruits or vegetables.

5- Celebrate America

Create an arrangement using red, white & blue fruits or vegetables to show your patriotism. No minimum amount of fruits or vegetables.
